Guidelines for personal belongings:

- As an example of Christian behavior, please make sure to bring modest clothing. All staff will enforce the dress code.
- Please mark all items for identification.
- Please, no personal electronic devices (i.e. CD players, stereos, etc.). Remember, our goal is to build each other up, not isolate ourselves.
- Make sure your squirt gun is clearly marked and checked in during registration time.

While at camp:

- To help prevent homesickness, we restrict the use of the public telephone to campers. No outgoing call can be made without permission of the camp director. Parents are encouraged to send letters or postcards to the campers. The address of the camp is:

- On Friday night, the last night of camp, refunds will be given for unused portions of the canteen or crafts card. It is the responsibility of the camper to get his or her own refund.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS:

- Please make sure your camper has enough clothes to last the week and that all clothing is modest.
- Transportation is to be provided by the individual family to and from camp. Campers should arrive no earlier than 1:00 PM on Sunday July 21, 2002. Lunch will not be served this day so be sure to eat before bringing them to the camp. The campers should be picked up no later than 9:00 AM Saturday July 27, 2002. The camp must be cleared by 10:00 AM on July 27, 2002. Please be punctual!
- All visitors should check in with Brian Ferguson or Jim Holland upon arrival. If you would like to share a meal with us, please arrange to pay \$2.00 per person per meal.
- No fast food should be brought to the campers during the week. Thank you!
